1. This is an independently juried competition open to any local artist
- 2.** Registration fees: \$35.00 for current GHA members and \$45.00 for non-members
- 3. Registration deadline: Friday April 6th, 2012**

### April 14th, 2012:

1. Enter through the main gate
2. Registration begins at 10 am on the east side of the Carriage House. You will receive an envelope with your name tag, an official show label & a smaller label for work that will be displayed in the exhibit
3. There will be coffee available in the Carriage House
4. Painting begins at 10 am until 4pm. You may choose any place on the estate to work
5. From noon - 1:30 pm snacks and drinks will be available, for participants only, in the Carriage House. Water will be available throughout the day
6. 4pm - all art work is to be brought to the Carriage House to be checked in for the night. You can also leave any easels, etc there overnight, since it will be closed & locked

### April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2012:

1. Registration will begin at 10 am in front of the Carriage House. You must have your ID badge to pickup work
2. There will be coffee available in the Carriage House
3. Painting begins at 10 am until 1 pm
4. From 12.00 - 1:30 pm snacks and drinks will be available, for participants only, in the Carriage House. Water will be available throughout the day
5. Between 1-1:30 pm – all work (work should not be signed on the front, your registration label with your assigned number should be placed in front of the work) is to be brought to the Palm Grove, located on the back lawn by the bay for the Judging. If you have an easel on which to place your piece please bring that also, since we have only a limited number of easels available. No one is to remain in this area during the time that the judge is making his/her decision
6. Judging will begin at 1:30 pm in the Palm Grove
7. The awards ceremony will begin at 2.30 pm

Deering Estate at Cutler is located at 16701 SW 72 Ave  
Old Cutler Rd to 167<sup>th</sup> Ave & turn east at the light, parking lot is on the right  
Open daily from 10 am to 5 pm

## Artists' Information

## Please keep and read this page for rules and information

1. **Participants may work in any medium, but work must be completed on the Deering Estate at Cutler premises during the time frames specified for the Affair En Plein Air**
2. All work must depict something on the Deering Estate at Cutler. Both traditional & contemporary interpretations are encouraged. Participants shall, under no circumstances, include any inappropriate or offensive nudity, political, religious, or racial comments as part of any art work. The Estate, through its Director, shall have the right to remove any & all art work that they deem inappropriate or offensive. Any artwork(s) to be displayed at the Estate must be approved & accepted by the Deering Estate at Cutler
3. We request that participants credit all work that is exhibited or reproduced elsewhere, as such: "Produced while visiting the Deering Estate at Cutler", additionally, all work that is created or reproduced while on the Estate or using Estate images shall not be for commercial use, & can only be made available for private exhibit or private sale
4. Artist's size limitation will be open this year. You choose your size.
5. Artists are expected to interact with anyone asking questions about your creation therefore, headphones are not permitted
6. Trash is not to be left in the area where you work
7. Smoking, alcohol consumption & illegal drugs are not allowed anywhere on the estate
8. Prizes will be awarded by an independent juror. No one except the juror & committee members will be allowed to be present at the judging
9. Any unclaimed work will be considered abandoned & will become the property of GroveHouse Artists
10. Participants agree to comply with the Deering Estate at Cutler Park Rules & Regulations
11. If you wish to come and see the Estate before the event, entrance is \$ 12 for adults and \$ 7 for children

### For En Plein Air Artists

1. Canvases or work surface can be primed in advance, however they must be completely blank at the start of the competition
2. Artists must report to the registration table at the beginning & end of each day
3. All artists must wear the ID tag given to them at registration while they are on the estate
4. Artists must provide all of their own supplies, including an easel if needed
5. Each piece of art must be labeled with the GHA tags provided
6. Light snacks & water will be provided to each artist on both days. There will also be coffee available in the mornings
7. All art is to be left in the designated room at the end of the day; no artwork is to leave the property before the end of the event
8. Canopies and umbrellas may be used
9. Dirty water or chemicals are NOT to be poured out onto the grounds
